



The Putrajaya Masterplan is a blueprint for a Federal Administrative City for Malaysia. The masterplan, covering 11,320 acres, was required to be no less than a functional and symbolic centre for religion and government. It also intentionally blends the elements of land, water and environment to create real estate value.
